CIRCULAR TO COUNCILS

The Tribunal is modifying its requirements for the provision of initial information from local councils.

Councils are no longer required to file three copies of initial material as requested in our standard correspondence.

The local council is to forward one copy of the complete file to the Tribunal.

If the matter proceeds to a full hearing, then Councils are to ensure that two additional copies of the development application and all reports associated with it are copied and send to the Tribunal for its panel members at the same time as evidence is exchanged between the parties.
